- ESTABLISHED:** Spring 1998, awarded annually thereafter.
- NUMBER and AMOUNT:** One, \$2,000 scholarship, paid in four installments of \$500 each year for four years of consecutive undergraduate education. Each \$500 payment will be sent each year in its entirety to the recipient's institution of higher education during the summer prior to enrollment.
- TERM:** \$500 first year, renewable for 3 additional consecutive years provided the student stays enrolled in good standing in an accredited institution of high education.
- USE:** Scholarship may be used for tuition, fees, room or board at any institution of higher learning anywhere for any course of study.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Any Lewiston High School graduating senior may apply for this scholarship who meets the following eligibility criteria:
1. Applicant must have a minimum Grade Pt. Ave. **(GPA) of 3.0**;
 2. Applicant must intend to pursue further education at an institution of higher learning in the fall following high school graduation;
 3. Applicant must possess high character traits befitting a quality graduate of Lewiston High School.
- Race, religion, or financial need will not be determining factors in making the award. Students intending to pursue their studies full-time will be preferred, but part-time students will be considered.
- APPLICATION DEADLINE:** **APRIL 15th** (If 15th falls on weekend, due following Monday.) Completed applications must be submitted to:

4. Your current Grade Point Average (GPA)
5. School activities you pursued
6. Volunteer or other Community activities
7. Please name the most challenging course or courses you took while attending LHS. Please include a copy of your high school transcript.
8. Career goal: Your reason for selecting this career goal; your plan for achieving this career goal; and your 4-year plan for higher education.
9. Please answer the following question with a brief essay:
"What character trait do you possess that will help you be most successful in the 21st Century?"
10. Your signature

SELECTION: Selection of a recipient and an alternate will be made by a committee composed of members of the Board of Directors of the Lewiston Independent Foundation for Education, Inc.
