- ESTABLISHED: Spring 2008, awarded annually thereafter.
- NUMBER and AMOUNT: One \$250 scholarship, to be used the fall following graduation.
- TERM: \$250 one time payment, which will be sent in its entirety to the recipient's institution of higher education prior to the start of the fall semester. Student must be enrolled full time.
- USE: Scholarship may be used for tuition, fees, room or board at any institution of higher learning anywhere for **studies in science**.
- ELIGIBILITY: Any Lewiston High School graduating senior may apply for this scholarship who meets the following eligibility criteria:
1. Applicant must have a minimum Grade Pt. Ave. **(GPA) of 3.5 in all classes, and 3.5 in science classes.**;
 2. Applicant must intend to pursue further education full time at an institution of higher learning in the fall following high school graduation, and **pursue a science or engineering degree**.
 3. Applicant must have taken a **science class all 4 years** of high school.
- Race, religion, or financial need will not be determining factors in making the award.
- APPLICATION DEADLINE:** **APRIL 15th** (If 15th falls on weekend, due following Monday.)

APPLICATION PROCESS: Interested applicants should submit their own application form and essay which should contain the following information:

Application Information:

1. Your full name
2. Your home address and phone number
3. Your parents' names
4. Your current Grade Point Average (GPA)
5. School activities you pursued
6. Volunteer or other community activities
7. Name the **science courses you took while attending LHS.**
8. **Career goal:** Your reason for selecting this career goal; your plan for achieving this career goal; and your 4-year plan for higher education. **You must be pursuing a career in science or engineering to be eligible for this scholarship.**
9. What institution of higher education do you plan to attend?
10. Your signature
11. **Please include a copy of your high school transcript.**
12. **Please include a letter of recommendation from a current or former science teacher.**

SELECTION: Selection of a recipient will be made by a committee composed of current science teachers, retired science teachers, and members of the LIFE Board of Directors.
