## (endowed scholarship)

- ESTABLISHED:** Summer 2018  
In honor of Jeanette Woody, a member of the Lewiston Fire Department for many years.  
Jeanette joined the LFD on December 17, 1984. She came from a very professional organization in California (TRW) so she started right in cleaning up files and organizing administration. Jeanette was not afraid of progress; in fact she was instrumental in setting up and creating an electronic filing system. This is basically the same system that is in place today. Jeanette's attention to detail, and her goal of perfection, brought the department to a new level. She controlled what came out of Administration, and it showed.  
In 2009 Jeanette retired from LFD. As was her way, she left without a party or a goodbye. Jeanette continues to reside in the Lewis-Clark Valley and continues to give back to the fire department, as proven by this scholarship.
- AMOUNT** One payment of \$500 to be used for the recipient's first semester of schooling at an institution for higher or continuing education.
- TERM:** One year scholarship only. Must be used during the calendar year in which it is awarded.
- USE:** This scholarship may be used toward tuition, fees, room or board at any institution for higher education, including technical and trade schools. If the scholarship is used for room and board, the recipient may incur a tax liability.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Any child or grandchild of a Lewiston Fire Department employee or retiree who will be enrolling in a higher education program during the calendar year in which the award is presented.
- Race, religion and gender will not be determining factors in awarding this scholarship.**
- APPLICATION DEADLINE:** **Applications must be received by May 1<sup>st</sup>.**

Interested applicants should submit their own application form and required attachments.

## **Application Information:**

1. Your full name
2. Your home address, email address and phone number
3. Your work experience
4. Other personal interests you have outside of school
5. Please list any volunteer or community service work you have performed.
6. **Short essay on the following questions:** (400 words or less)
  1. *What are your career goals and what prompted you to pursue this career?*
  2. *Give an example of someone or some situation that has impacted your life.*
  3. *What single character trait is most important to you, and why?*
  4. *Describe how you have demonstrated leadership in the last year.*
7. **Write a letter** to the committee stating why you should be awarded this scholarship.
8. **Attach a letter of recommendation** from someone who can speak to your character.
9. **Attach a copy of your high school transcript.**
10. Please **sign and date** your application as an affirmation of the accuracy and truthfulness of the information you provide.

Transcript scoring 0 to 5

- 0.0 to 1.0 = 0
- 1.0 to 2.0 = 1
- 2.0 to 2.5 = 2
- 2.5 to 3.0 = 3
- 3.0 to 3.5 = 4
- 3.5 to 4.0 = 5

- Letter of Recommendation 0 to 5
- Essay Scoring 0 to 5
- Letter Scoring 0 to 20
- Follow Instructions 0 to 5

***Committee will be comprised of 3 evaluators:  
2 members of IAFF Local 1773 and 1 member of the current L.I.F.E. Board.  
The two representatives from the local will be recommended by the current E-board, and the current L.I.F.E. Board representative will be chosen by that board.***

A selection will take place no later than June 1<sup>st</sup>. The recipient will be notified in a timely manner.
