

Jonas Yochum Memorial School Spirit Scholarship

Administered by Lewiston Independent Foundation for Education, Inc.

Established: June, 2011, by Terry and Marlene Yochum in memory of their son, Jonas Yochum, who died in a boating accident at the start of his sophomore year at LHS. First scholarship will be awarded in spring of 2013, the year Jonas would have graduated, and annually thereafter.

Criteria

Amount: \$500 for the first year of college, paid as a single payment.

Term: Scholarship must be used in its entirety during the first year of the student's college education. If student delays entering college, scholarship may be deferred for no later than the 3rd fall quarter following graduation. Scholarship may be used for tuition, fees, room, board, or any college related expenses. Student may incur tax liability for any amount applied to room and board. Race, religion, or gender will not be determining factors in making the reward.

Qualifications: The recipient must have demonstrated exemplary school spirit during his or her time at Lewiston High School. In addition, the recipient must have earned at least 3.10 grade point average (GPA) at the time of graduation from Lewiston High School.

Selection: Students do not apply for this scholarship. The recipient will be selected by Lewiston High School staff and administration.

The L.I.F.E. Office will send a reminder to the Vice Principal's office in January, and the nomination and selection process will be initiated by that office.

The endowment is guaranteed a 5% spending interest amount each year, with the understanding that 5% of that amount will be returned to the endowment to continue building principal. The amount of the scholarship award may be increased from time to time at the discretion of the L.I.F.E. Board of Directors, as funds allow. Any increased award amount will be communicated to the LHS Vice Principal's Office, and to the LHS Counseling Office, after approval of such increase by the L.I.F.E. Board of Directors.
