

Bradley J. Crosby Memorial Music Scholarship

Administered by Lewiston Independent Foundation for Education, Inc.

(endowed scholarship)

- ESTABLISHED:** Spring 1997
In memory of Bradley J. Crosby, a member of the Lewiston High School Class of 1986, who was killed in a traffic collision in Beaverton, Oregon, along with his wife on February 11, 1996.
- NUMBER and AMOUNT:** One \$600 scholarship for the first year of college.
The scholarship will be sent in halves to the recipient's institution of higher education prior to the start of each semester of the recipient's first year.
- TERM:** One year scholarship only.
- USE:** Scholarship may be used for tuition, fees, room or board at any institution of higher learning or similar academy. Student may incur tax liability for any amount applied to room and board.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Any Lewiston High School graduating senior may apply for this scholarship who meets the following eligibility criteria:
1. Applicant must have been involved in **music studies** (instrumental or vocal) and performance, either through the school or in the community or both;
 2. Applicant must intend to pursue further education full-time at an institution of higher learning in the fall following high school graduation. *Applicants intending to pursue further music training and/or involvement will be preferred.*
- Race, religion, gender, or financial need will not be determining factors in making the award.**
- APPLICATION DEADLINE:** Completed application should be submitted to the LHS Counselors in the College & Career Counseling Center **by April 15. If this date falls on a weekend, the application is due on Monday.**

Interested applicants should submit their own application form and essay which should contain the following information:

1. Your full name

3. Your parents' names
4. Your cumulative G.P.A.
5. Your involvement in music while in school
6. Other activities you pursued while in school.
7. Other personal interests you may have

8. Career goal:

- Your reason for selecting this career goal;
- Your plan for achieving this career goal;
- and the College or Institution you plan to attend this coming fall.
