- ESTABLISHED:** Spring 2017. John Rudolph was a much respected teacher and football coach. He retired in 1995 after teaching machine shop for 34 years at LHS, and passed away in 2007. David C. Howell, President/CEO of HMT Group, was a student of Mr. Rudolph's during his high school years. During this time, as a result of Mr. Rudolph's mentoring, David learned many of the core skills which have led to the success of Howell Munitions & Technology.
- NUMBER and AMOUNT:** One \$500 scholarship for the first year of college. The scholarship will be sent in halves to the recipient's institution of higher education prior to the start of each semester of the recipient's first year.
- TERM:** One year scholarship only.
- USE:** This scholarship may be used for tuition and fees at any institution of higher learning, including trade or technical schools. Student must be entering a Machining, Fabrication, or Manufacturing course of study.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Any Lewiston High School graduating senior may apply for this scholarship who meets the following eligibility criteria:
1. Minimum grade point average (GPA): 2.5
 2. Must have taken machine shop, Skills USA, or similar courses during high school.
 3. Preferred applicants will demonstrate a work ethic, community involvement, and a willingness to return to the LC Valley and help build the community.
- Race, religion, and gender will not be determining factors in making the award.**
- APPLICATION DEADLINE:** **Applications must be received by April 1st.**

APPLICATION PROCESS: Interested applicants should submit their own application form and essay which should contain the following information:

Application Information:

1. Name, home address, phone number and email address
2. Parents' names
3. Cumulative GPA
Attach a copy of your most recent transcript.
4. College you plan to attend

Preference will be given to students enrolled full-time (12 or more credits.) However, students enrolled part-time (6-12 credits) may be considered. Please attach an explanation of the circumstances preventing full-time enrollment.
5. School and community activities you pursued
6. Career goal: Your reason for selecting this career goal; your plan for achieving this career goal; and your 2 to 4-year plan for higher education. **This plan must include a major in Precision Machining, Machining Technology, Fabrication, or a similar field of study.**
7. Finalists for this scholarship may be contacted for an interview by the HMT Group selection committee.
8. Please **sign and date** your application form as an affirmation of the accuracy and truthfulness of the information you provide.
