- ESTABLISHED: Spring, 2013
- NUMBER and AMOUNT: One \$500 one-time gift scholarship, to be used the fall following graduation.
- TERM: The scholarship will be sent in halves to the recipient's institution of higher education prior to the start of each semester of the recipient's first year. Student must be enrolled full time.
- USE: Scholarship may be used for tuition, fees, room or board at any institution of higher learning anywhere for any course of study.
- ELIGIBILITY: Any Lewiston High School graduating senior may apply for this scholarship who meets the following eligibility criteria:
1. Applicant must have a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.75.
 2. Applicant must intend to pursue further education full time at an institution of higher learning in the fall following high school graduation.
- Race, religion, or financial need will not be determining factors in making the award.
- APPLICATION DEADLINE:** **March 15th** (If the 15th falls on weekend, due following Monday). Completed applications must be submitted to the LHS Counseling Center.
