

Pete & Frances Dewey Carroll Music Scholarship

Administered by Lewiston Independent Foundation for Education, Inc.

(Trust Fund endowed scholarship)

- ESTABLISHED: The scholarship was created in 1991 by Frances Dewey Carroll, who graduated from LHS in 1936 and dedicated her life to teaching music in the school district, continuing to do so part time after her retirement. Fran Carroll passed away in 2002 at the age of 85.
- AMOUNT: One \$300 scholarship for the first year of college.
- TERM: One year scholarship only.
- USE: Scholarship may be used for tuition, fees, room or board at any Idaho institution of higher education. Student may incur tax liability for any amount applied to room and board.
- ELIGIBILITY: Any Lewiston High School graduating senior may apply for this scholarship who meets the following eligibility criteria:
1. Applicant must have taken either vocal or instrumental music at some time in the secondary schools of the Lewiston School District.
 2. Applicant must intend to attend a school in Idaho.
 3. Applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- APPLICATION DEADLINE: Completed application should be submitted to the LHS Counselors in the College & Career Counseling Center **by April 15. If this date falls on a weekend, the application is due on Monday.**
