

Earl Wright & Shirley Wright Memorial Music Scholarship

Administered by Lewiston Independent Foundation for Education, Inc.

(Trust Fund endowed scholarship)

- ESTABLISHED:** Earl and Shirley Wright were the only children of Rex and Dollie Wright. Both Earl and Shirley loved music, and both Earl and Shirley died when they were teenagers, in separate accidents. When Dollie died in 1990 she left a bequest to establish the scholarship.
- AMOUNT:** One \$500 scholarship for the first year of college. It will be paid in halves, \$250 for each semester.
- TERM:** One year scholarship only.
- USE:** Scholarship may be used for tuition, fees, room or board at any Idaho institution of higher education. Student may incur tax liability for any amount applied to room and board.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Any Lewiston High School graduating senior may apply for this scholarship who meets the following eligibility criteria:
1. Applicant must have participated in music education or activities during high school;
 2. Applicant must intend to pursue a college program in music.
- APPLICATION DEADLINE:** Completed application should be submitted to the LHS Counselors in the College & Career Counseling Center **by April 15. If this date falls on a weekend, the application is due on Monday.**
