

# Eddy Williams Memorial Music Scholarship

Administered by Lewiston Independent Foundation for Education, Inc.

## (endowed scholarship)

- ESTABLISHED:** Spring 2016  
In memory of Eddy Williams, long time music teacher and band instructor in the Lewiston School District. Mr. Williams was an inspiration to his students, giving them unforgettable memories such as traveling to Washington DC in 1973 and 1977 for presidential inaugural parades or playing in the jazz band during a six-country European tour. Eddy Williams was recipient of the Governor's Award for Excellence in 1974, and he was admitted into the Idaho Music Educators' Hall of Fame in 2014.
- NUMBER and AMOUNT:** One \$1,000 scholarship, to be used the fall following graduation.
- TERM:** The scholarship will be sent in halves to the recipient's institution of higher education prior to the start of each semester of the recipient's first year. Student must be enrolled full time.
- USE:** Scholarship may be used for tuition, fees, room or board at any institution of higher learning or similar academy. Student may incur tax liability for any amount applied to room and board.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Any Lewiston High School graduating senior may apply for this scholarship who meets the following eligibility criteria:
1. Applicant must have been involved in **music studies** (instrumental or vocal) and performance, either through the school or in the community or both. Preference will be given to applicants with strong instrumental backgrounds.
  2. Applicant must participate in some form of music education while in college.
- APPLICATION DEADLINE:** Completed application should be submitted to the LHS Counselors in the College & Career Counseling Center **by April 15. If this date falls on a weekend, the application is due on Monday.**

APPLICATION Interested applicants should submit their own **application form** and  
PROCESS: **essay** which should contain the following information:

### **Application Information:**

1. Your full name
2. Your home address and phone number
3. Your parents' names
4. Your cumulative G.P.A.
5. Your involvement in music while in school
6. Other activities you pursued while in school.
7. Other personal interests you may have
8. Your education and career goal
9. College you plan to attend
10. Your signature affirming the accuracy of the information you have provided

**Please attach a copy of your current transcript.**

**Include an essay** in response to the following question:  
**What has music meant in your life?**

SELECTION: Selection of a recipient will be made by family and friends of Eddy Williams. The recipient will be announced at the year-end Awards Assembly.
