

# Earl Pepper Memorial Scholarship

Administered by Lewiston Independent Foundation for Education, Inc.

- ESTABLISHED:** Spring 2020  
In memory of Earl Pepper, who passed away in August of 2019 at the age of 81 following a bout with cancer. Earl was a hardworking, practical man who worked to build the Lewis-Clark Highway between Kooskia and Lolo, and then retired after 38 years with the Bureau of Public Roads. He and his wife, Lucille (a long-time sub with the Lewiston School District) took great pride in their acreage in Tammany where he spent 20 years raising and training quarter horses for racing. Earl was proud of Lucille's work in the schools and wanted this scholarship to be created. It was funded through memorial donations from friends and family.
- NUMBER and AMOUNT** One, one-time \$1,750 scholarship for the first year of college. The scholarship will be sent in halves to the recipient's institution of higher education prior to the start of each semester of the recipient's first year.
- TERM:** One year scholarship only.  
Student must be enrolled full-time at an institution of higher learning starting in the fall of 2020. Scholarship may not be deferred.
- USE:** Scholarship may be used for tuition, fees, room or board at any institution of higher learning or similar academy. Student may incur tax liability for any amount applied to room and board.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Any Lewiston High School graduating senior may apply for this scholarship who meets the following eligibility criteria:
1. Minimum 3.5 GPA
  2. Intent to pursue a course of study leading to work in the medical field or in medical research.
- APPLICATION DEADLINE:** Completed application should be submitted to the LHS Counselors in the College & Career Counseling Center **by April 15.**

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## Earl Pepper Memorial Scholarship (continued)

**APPLICATION PROCESS:** Interested applicants should submit their own application form and essay which should contain the following information:

### **Application Information:**

1. Your full name
2. Your email (permanent, not one supplied by school)
2. Your home address and phone number
3. Your parents' names
4. Your cumulative G.P.A. in grades 9-12  
**(Attach a copy of your transcript)**
5. Other activities you pursued while in school (clubs, sports, jobs)
6. College, course of study, and career goal you intend to pursue.
7. Your signature

Please submit an essay in response to the following questions:

- 1) Why are you interested in the medical field?
- 2) How have you, a family member, or a close friend been affected by cancer?
- 3) What is your plan to pay for college? (loans, parental support, working, scholarships, etc.) What steps have you taken to prepare for the expense?

**DEADLINE:** Completed applications should be submitted to the LHS Counselors in the College & Career Counseling Center **by APRIL 15.**

**SELECTION:** Selection of a recipient and an alternate will be made by members of Earl Pepper's family. The recipient will be announced at the awards assembly on May 26<sup>th</sup> at Lewiston High School.
