## (endowed scholarship)

- ESTABLISHED: Spring 2009
- NUMBER and USE: One \$800 scholarship for the first year of college. The scholarship will be sent in halves to the recipient's institution of higher education prior to the start of each semester of the recipient's first year.
- Scholarship may be used for tuition, fees, room, board, or any college related expenses at any institution of higher learning or similar academy. Student may incur tax liability for any amount applied to room and board.
- ELIGIBILITY: Any Lewiston High School graduating senior may apply for this scholarship who meets the following eligibility criteria:
1. Student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above.
  2. Application must demonstrate financial need.
- APPLICATION DEADLINE: Completed application should be submitted to the LHS Counselors in the College & Career Counseling Center **by April 15. If this date falls on a weekend, the application is due on the following Monday.**
- APPLICATION PROCESS: Interested applicants should submit a completed application form with required attachments.
- SELECTION: Selection of a recipient and an alternate will be made by a selection committee composed of representatives from the LHS Alumni Association and the Board of the Lewiston Independent Foundation for Education.
