

# Fred Scheibe Drama Scholarship

Administered by Lewiston Independent Foundation for Education, Inc.

## (non-endowed scholarship)

- ESTABLISHED:** Spring 1996  
Fred Scheibe was a graduate of LHS, who danced professionally in Broadway shows and returned to Lewiston to become the artistic director of the Lewiston Civic Theatre until his retirement. He also directed LHS musicals that won State drama awards.
- NUMBER and AMOUNT:** One \$500 scholarship for the first year of college.  
The scholarship will be sent in halves to the recipient's institution of higher education prior to the start of each semester of the recipient's first year.
- TERM:** One year scholarship only.
- USE:** Scholarship may be used for tuition, fees, room or board at any institution of higher learning or similar academy. Student may incur tax liability for any amount applied to room and board.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Any Lewiston High School graduating senior may apply for this scholarship who meets the following eligibility criteria:
1. Demonstrates theatrical excellence in drama productions at Lewiston High School, as well as in community theatre productions (i.e. Lewiston Civic Theatre, LCSC , Jenifer & Sac Middle Schools, etc.)
  2. Maintains a GPA of 2.0 or better
  3. Demonstrates financial need.
  4. Preference given to students planning to pursue a major in Theatre Arts, Education, or the Fine/Performing Arts.
- APPLICATION DEADLINE:** Completed application should be submitted to the LHS Counselors in the College & Career Counseling Center **by April 15. If this date falls on a weekend, the application is due on Monday.**

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## Fred Scheibe Drama Scholarship (continued)

APPLICATION Interested applicants should submit their own application form which should contain the following information:

### **Application Information:**

1. Your full name
2. Your home address and phone number
3. Your permanent email address (not school address)
4. Your parents' names
5. Your cumulative G.P.A. in grades 9-12
6. Resume of theatrical activities and involvement
7. College and course of study you intend to pursue.
8. Your ultimate career goals.

**Attach a copy** of your official Lewiston High School transcript

**Attach a letter of reference** from a counselor, a teacher, or an adult mentor.

**Attach an essay** in which you indicate the influence of theatre in your life. Include an explanation of your future goals, financial need, and a summary of your participation in high school and community activities.

DEADLINE: Completed applications should be submitted to the LHS Counselors in the College & Career Counseling Center by **APRIL 15. If this date falls on a weekend, the application is due on Monday.**

SELECTION: Selection of a recipient and an alternate will be made by members of the Fitzgerald-Atkinson Family.
